JULY 6 – 10

Master Chef Jr.

Throughout-the-week, campers will explore nearby outdoor spaces while participating in scavenger hunts, clue-solving missions, and map-reading activities. Campers will also learn the basics of geocaching etiquette and how GPS-based treasure hunting works around the world. Get ready to follow the clues, solve the puzzles, and discover hidden treasures!
